- **Are confident and enthusiastic about being a leader.** Bruins aren't reluctant role models. They are confident, honest, and passionate leaders who take on challenges for the greater good.
- **Come from diverse backgrounds.** Bruins have unique life stories, are from different places, have varied academic ambitions, and play a wide range of sports.
- **Represent the qualities of those inducted into the Bartlesville Sports Commission Hall of Fame:**
  - Proactive and highly motivated
  - Inspiring and charismatic
  - Honest and trustworthy
  - Genuine
  - Strong and courageous



To be eligible for the BSC Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a graduating high-school senior of the class of 2023, pursuing an undergraduate degree at a two- or four-year community college or four-year school.
- Have been involved in varsity athletics.
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent legal resident (you will be asked to prove citizenship and age if you win).
