- **Are confident and enthusiastic about being a leader.** Bruins are positive, eager role models. They are confident, honest, and passionate leaders who take on challenges for the greater good.
- **Come from diverse backgrounds.** Bruins have unique life stories, are from different places, have varied academic ambitions, and play a wide range of sports.
- **Excel in athletics.** Bruins train hard, give 110% and inspire their teammates through action and word. They are often involved in more than one sport.

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent legal resident
